

#### **Brief History**



ABET

 Ten visits are in the U.S. and will be conducted in person. Six program evaluation visits to foreign institutions will be completed virtually.





- The PE Exam is administered annually in October
- The PE Review course will be held in September 2022 in Denver, CO
- The 2021 PE Exam was the first computerized examination for the Mining/Mineral Processing discipline
- The PE Committee is supervising the writing of Edition II, *Mining Reference Handbook* 
  - This will be the single-reference allowed in the PE exam beginning in 2021
