

• 1853 Total Inspectable Units- average is 28 units/inspector














Joint Task Force with University of Kentucky and Professor Braden Lusk



The Department will be providing information from flyrock events during 2011-2012. Once these two years have been reviewed, records from 2008, 2009, and 2010 will be processed. The data collected will be analyzed to find trends that are the most common causes of flyrock events.


